The Criteria

Candidates must:

- Demonstrate strong academic success with a minimum GPA equivalent of B or higher;
- Demonstrate significant volunteer contributions to her community;
- Demonstrate strong character;
- Be able to easily express her personal philosophy or purpose as to why it is important to volunteer;
- Be well-rounded;
- Be in the process of applying to or already accepted at an accredited two or four year college or university; and,
- Submit a brief essay and other materials as outlined below.
- Must attend one of the following high schools
 - Joliet West or Central High School
 - Joliet Catholic Academy
 - Minooka High School
 - Providence Catholic High School

The Procedure

- Applications and all materials must be postmarked no later than **April 1st, 2023**.
- Applicants may be required to participate in an interview process.
- Selection process will be completed and the recipient notified 1st week of May.
- Our recipient(s) will be formally invited to attend our JJWC Reciprocity Dinner May 25th, 2023

Materials to be provided to Scholarship Committee *

- letter of nomination/recommendation from teacher or guidance counselor
- one additional letter of recommendation from a teacher
- a personal letter from the applicant stating her future educational plans
- an official high school transcript including ACT or SAT scores
- an optional character reference letter
- a personal essay
